A dynamic nonprofit helps reach kids the largely unwritten rules of success.

"I have seen the transformative power of education," says Dominique Jordan Turner, president and CEO of Chicago Scholars (chicago-scholars.org). "Success is not just about the right education or the right grades. If you grow up poor, black or brown in this city, that is not enough." Born to a teenage mother, Turner grew up in a Chicago housing project and is also the first member of her family to graduate from college. At her innovative nonprofit, she leads a team that works to ensure that students from under-resourced communities have a path to college and success, more broadly defined. Each student who enters the seven-year program is counseled, trained and mentored; even those who already have many of the skills they need learn the unwritten rules for success. "There can be a success story."

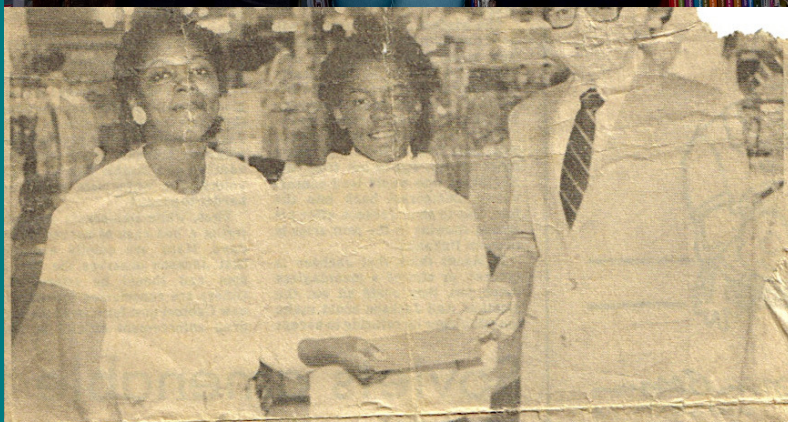
DYNAMIC, ENGAGING STORYTELLER

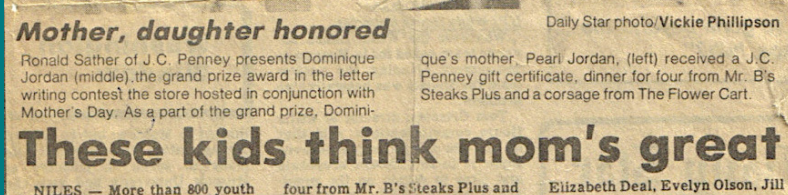
